ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On July 2, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by John F. Reed, D.D.S., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided in the Board's *Final Decision and Order* dated March 6, 2002. The Board also reviewed three additional requests of Dr. Reed to modify the Order.

Based upon the Board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that John F. Reed, D.D.S., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of License #015-3877 to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Reed's request to reduce the number of therapy sessions to two per month is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Reed's request to reduce the required number of annual urine screens is **DENIED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Reed's request to change the protocol for his urine screen samples is **DENIED**.

Please be advised that the next submission of reports and the petition for an extension of a stay of suspension are due on August 25, 2003.
