On May 22, 2002, the Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board reprimanded Dr. James A. Dickerson and limited Dr. Dickerson's license to practice psychology in the State of Wisconsin, requiring him to enter into and successfully participate in treatment by an approved psychiatrist. The board approved Barry M. Altenberg, M.D. as Dr. Dickerson's treating psychiatrist.

In a letter dated January 17, 2003, Dr. Altenberg stated his opinion that he does not foresee any problems in terminating therapy. In response to a phone call on March 12, 2003 to clarify Dr. Dickerson's compliance with the board's order, Dr. Altenberg confirmed that he received copies of the board's Final Decision and Order, Dr. Seaman's evaluation, Dr. Dobovsky's evaluation, and Dr. Buchanan's letter. The board confirmed with the Department's Division of Enforcement that Dr. Dickerson is current in his continuing education requirement. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the limitations placed on the license to practice psychology issued to James A. Dickerson are hereby removed and Dr. Dickerson will be issued an unlimited license.
