ORDER TERMINATING SUSPENSION

The Board of nursing entered its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter on August 9, 2002. Under the terms of the board's Order, Mr. Maslach's license was suspended for one year, with provision for consecutive three month stays of the suspension to be granted upon completion by Mr. Maslach of 20 hours of continuing education in IV therapy, and six hours of continuing education in nursing ethics. The Order also required that Mr. Maslach be responsible for submission of quarterly reports to the board prepared by Mr. Maslach's employer.

On August 9, 2002, the board granted Mr. Maslach's request for an initial three month stay of the suspension.

On November 7, 2002, February 7, 2003, and April 18, 2003, the board granted Mr. Maslach's requests for further three month stays of the suspension.

On August 8, 2003, the board considered Mr. Maslach's request for a further three month stay of the suspension, and his further request that all limitations on his license be terminated. While the one year period of suspension will have expired as of August 9, 2003, the requirement for quarterly work reports does not expire until August, 2004. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Henry J. Maslach, RN, is hereby terminated. Mr. Maslach shall continue to provide quarterly reports prepared by his employer on a quarterly basis.
