On November 22, 2002, the Medical Examining Board entered its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Dr. Jeckle's license was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that should Dr. Jeckle wish to resume his practice of Medicine and surgery in Wisconsin, he may petition the board for termination of the suspension, and shall appear before the board in support of any such petition.

On January 22, 2003, the board considered Dr. Jeckle's letter of December 18, 2002, by which he petitions for rehearing. As grounds for the petition, Dr. Jeckle indicates that, while he thought he was being represented in this matter by competent counsel, it appears that his counsel was not actively participating in his defense.

Under sec. 227.49(2), Stats., a rehearing may be granted only on the basis of some material error of law, some material error of fact, or the discovery of new evidence sufficiently strong to reverse or modify the order, and which could not have been previously discovered by due diligence. Because Dr. Jeckle does not allege any material error of law or fact, and does not allege discovery of new evidence relating to the underlying facts, the board must order as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Rehearing of Milan Jeckle, M.D. be, and hereby is, denied.
