Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Rayne Susan Stevens (Date of Birth: January 1, 1959) is duly licensed as a Practical Nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #24001). This license was first granted on May 29, 1981.
- 2. Ms. Stevens' most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 822 Christiana Street, Green Bay, Wisconsin, 54303.

3. On July 19, 2002, Ms. Stevens was convicted in Brown County Circuit Court of two counts of Class A Misdemeanor Theft-Movable Property, value of the property not exceeding \$2,500.00. The factual basis for this conviction involved theft by Ms. Stevens from a patient assigned to her care. A true and correct copy of the Brown County Criminal Complaint and Judgment of Conviction is attached as Exhibit A.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Stevens consents to the issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to sec. 441.07, Wis. Stats.
2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
3. The conduct described in paragraph 4, above, violated §N 7.04 (1) and (15), Wis. Adm. Code and sec. 441.07(1)(d), Wis. Stats.
ORDER
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that
 The Board of Nursing ACCEPTS the SURRENDER of thelicensed practical nurse license of Rayne Susan Stevens (license #24001).
2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Ms. Stevens reapply for licensure as a licensed practical nurse, the Board of Nursing may in its sole discretion determine, whether, and under what terms and conditions, this license may be reissued.
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
