On November 11, 2002, the Board of Nursing. Entered its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Order, Ms. Granlund's license was limited to require that within one year from the effective date of the Order, Ms. Granlund submit proof of conducting at least three (3) presentations of nursing staff inservices acceptable to the Board on subject areas pre-approved by the Board as relevant to the findings of this order. The subject areas included, but were not limited to, charting, legal aspects of nursing, and caring for patients with circulatory problems.

In the alternative, Respondent was required to submit within six months from the effective date of the Order documentation of successful completion of at least 12 hours of continuing nursing education approved by the Board in the subject areas of patient charting and legal aspects of nursing and six hours in caring for patients with circulatory problems, or in other areas approved by the Board.

Upon successful completion of the terms of the Order, the Board was to grant a petition by Ms. Granlund to restore her license to full and unrestricted status.

On May 9, 2003, the board considered Ms. Granlund's petition for termination of the limitations on her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Nancy A. Granlund, RN, to practice as a professional nurse are terminated, and Ms. Granlund is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
