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On November 7, 2002, the Board of Nursing entered its Final decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Sedlar's license was limited to require that she refrain from practicing in any nursing employment in any facility licensed by the Department of Health and Family Services until such time as she successfully completes a rehabilitation review administered by DH&FS. She is required to work under supervision acceptable to the board, and refrain from nursing employment as a pool nurse or visiting nurse (or other home care practitioner); and from working as a charge nurse. Additionally, within nine months of the date of the board's Order, Ms. Sedlar was required to submit acceptable documentation of successful completion of an LPN refresher course acceptable to the Board; and within 12 months from the date of the order, she was required submit documentation acceptable to the Board of successful return demonstration of a full and working knowledge of patient rights. Finally, for a period of at least one year from the date of the Order, Respondent was required to arrange for quarterly reports from her nursing employer(s) reporting the terms and conditions of her employment and evaluating her work performance.

On October 3, 2003, the board considered evidence that Ms. Sedlar had failed to provide the required work reports or evidence of having completed the LPN refresher course. In response, Ms. Sedlar wrote that she is unable to be employed as an LPN because she has not yet successfully completed the rehabilitation review. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations set forth on the board's November 7, 2002, Final Decision and Order shall remain in place until Ms. Sedlar has satisfactorily completed all the conditions requirements placed on her limited license.
