On May 14, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Gregory J. Teche, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated November 12, 2002. ("Order"), and a request for modification of the prohibition against his working as a pharmacist in charge contained in paragraph 2c(3) of the *Order*.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Gregory J. Teche, is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #10612 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modification of the prohibition against Gregory J. Teche working as a pharmacist in charge as provided within the board's *Order*, paragraph 2c(3), is granted with no limitation as to hours worked. This order is conditioned upon Gregory J. Teche working as a nuclear pharmacist only, and working as an employee with Amersham Health Services in Milwaukee only. Any change in these conditions requires a new petition to be filed with the board to request further approval to work as a pharmacist in charge.
