ORDER SUSPENDING THE LICENSE

On December 5, 2002, the Board of nursing entered its Final decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Van Ness-Wittrock's license was limited to require in part that she complete within six months six hours of continuing education in the area of universal precautions and infection control, and four hours of continuing education in the area of legal responsibilities of nursing. On August 8, 2003, the board considered evidence that Ms. Van Ness-Wittrock had failed to comply with the board's Order. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

<u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Christine Van Ness-Wittrock to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin is suspended. Ms. Wittrock may apply for reinstatement of the license upon submission of satisfactory evidence of having fully complied with the board's Order.
