On May 14, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed evidence in the form of a police report of the City of Ripon Police Department, dated April 12, 2003, indicating that Oestreich was reported to be videotaped drinking alcohol while on duty as a pharmacist. The police were called by his employer. After a search of Oestreich's car, controlled substances were found as well as empty wine cooler bottles. After further police investigation, Oestreich was arrested for a violation of Wis. Stats. §§ 346.88(1), 943.50(1M), and 961.41 (3G), (A)1. His probation agent reported orally to the department monitor, Michelle Neverman, that Oestreich is currently being held as an inpatient at a psychiatric ward at a hospital in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

Based upon the foregoing information and in order to protect the public,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay of the suspension of Duane A. Oestreich, pursuant to the *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") in the above-captioned matter entered on December 10, 2002, for license #8131, to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, is REVOKED.
