The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department. The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On July 25, 2000, Jason A. Fordyce (Date of Birth: November 24, 1978) was first granted a Private Security Permit (#14991) by the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing. The license expired on September 1, 2002. Mr. Fordyce has the right to renew this license upon payment of a late fee and the renewal credential fee pursuant to sec. 440.08(3) Wis. Stats. Mr. Fordyce has not at this date submitted any renewal fees and late fees for his Private Security Permit.
- 2. Mr. Forydce's last address known to the Division of Enforcement is 46 Cumberland Street, Lebanon, PA 17042.

- 3. On August 2, 2001, Mr. Fordyce was convicted in Dane County Circuit Court of one charge of County Retail Theft, a violation of a Dane County Ordinance. A true and correct copy of the Dane County Forfeiture Complaint and Stipulation and Order is attached as Exhibit A.
- 4. Mr. Fordyce failed to report his August 2, 2001, conviction to the Department of Regulation and Licensing.
- 5. Mr. Fordyce has moved from the state of Wisconsin and has indicated that he wishes to voluntary surrender his Private Security Permit.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Failure to notify the Department of Regulation and Licensing of a conviction within 48 hours after the judgment of conviction as described in the above Findings of Fact is a violation of Sec. 440.26(4m)(b), Wis. Stats and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2).
- 2. Under Sec. 440.26(6)(a)1, Wis. Stats. the Department may revoke, suspend or limit the license or permit of any person who has violated any state or local law punishable by a forfeiture.
- 3. Under Sec. 440.26(6)(a)2, Wis. Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2), the Department may revoke, suspend or limit the license or permit of any person who has engaged in conduct reflecting adversely on his or her professional qualification. By the conduct described in the above Findings of Fact, Mr. Fordyce engaged in conduct reflecting adversely on his professional qualification.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- 1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing ACCEPTS the SURRENDER of the Private Security Permit of Jason A. Fordyce (permit #14991).
- 2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Mr. Fordyce reapply for a Wisconsin Private

 Security Permit, the Department of Regulation and Licensing may in its sole discretion

 determine, whether, and under what terms and conditions, this permit may be reissued.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of signing.
