On February 7, 2003, the Board of Nursing entered its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Zarzana's license was limited to require that within 90 days from the date of the order, she submit acceptable documentation of successful completion of the University of Wisconsin School of Nursing on-line continuing education program entitled "Legal Issues for Nurses in Today's Health Care Environment", or of completion of other training pre-approved by the Board.

Also, within six months from the effective date of the Order, Ms. Zarzana was to submit documentation of successful completion of at least six (6) additional hours of continuing nursing education pre-approved by the Board in the subject areas of professional ethics and legal aspects of nursing

On July 23, 2003, Ms. Zarzana was notified by letter that failure to submit evidence of compliance with the ordered requirements by August 1, 2003, would result in referral of the matter to the Division of Enforcement. In response, Ms. Zarzana added a note to the bottom of the letter stating, "I sent in my license with a letter stating I was retiring on 29 March, '03. I have not practiced since the end of January, '03." The board considers this to be a request for voluntary surrender of Ms. Zarzana's license, and therefore orders as follows:

# <u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of the license of Angelina Zarzana, LPN, be, and hereby is, accepted.
