The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Department of Regulation and Licensing. The Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department of Regulation and Licensing adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. **Tennell R. Gholar**, (“Respondent”), date of birth 03/27/77, is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as Private Security Person having license # 108-14334. This license was first granted to him on 05/24/00. Respondent’s most recent address is 4159 N. 39th St., Milwaukee, WI 53216.
2. At all times relevant hereto, respondent was working as a Private Security Person for Metropolitan Special Protection LLC, located at 1925 W. National Ave., Milwaukee, WI.

3. On or about June 8, 2001, Respondent was working as a security guard at Ralph's Lounge in Milwaukee, WI. A Milwaukee Police Officer entered Ralph's Lounge and noticed that Respondent was wearing street clothes and was armed with a 9mm semi-automatic pistol.

4. The Milwaukee Police Officer approached Respondent and asked him to identify himself. Respondent identified himself and stated that he worked at Metropolitan Special Protection but was "freelancing" by working security at the bar. The Police Officer informed Respondent that he was to wear his uniform when providing security guard services. Respondent explained that he could not wear his uniform when working on the side because it would violate Metropolitan Special Protection's work rules. Respondent then proceeded to put on a pullover sweater with the word "Security" on the back.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 440.26(6).

2. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.

3. Respondent **Tennell R. Gholar** has violated:

a. Wis. Admin. Code sec. RL 31.01(1) 2, RL 33.02 and RL 34.01(1) by operating as a private detective agency without a current private detective agency license and by not wearing a uniform while providing private security guard services when working for Ralph's Lounge.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE , IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that **Tennell R. Gholar**, Private Security Person license # 108-14334 be, and hereby is, **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file # 01 RSG 022 be, and hereby is, closed.
