On April 7, 2003, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order adopting a stipulation in this case. The order required respondent Cornell Stallworth to pay a forfeiture of \$2,400 on a payment plan, and that "in the event Curl Up and Dye, Inc., & Cornell Stallworth fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the Barbering and Cosmetology establishment license of Curl Up & Dye, Inc., and the Barbering and Cosmetology Manager license of Cornell Stallworth SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until respondents have complied with the terms of this order."

On May 29, 2003, the Department Monitor informed Mr. Stallworth that he had failed to make payments as required by his payment plan, and that his Barbering and Cosmetologist Manager license was suspended. The Barbering and Cosmetology establishment license of Curl Up & Dye, Inc., was not suspended, presumably because the establishment license for Curl Up & Dye, Inc. at that location had been terminated. On September 30, 2003, Mr. Stallworth wrote to the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board requesting that the suspension of his license be lifted so that he might work to earn money to pay the forfeitures. On October 6, 2003, Mr. Stallworth presented a payment of \$173 to the Department. The Board reviewed Mr. Stallworth's letter on October 6, 2003 and voted to grant his request and to impose a new payment plan, including a provision for an automatic suspension if the payment plan is not followed. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Barbering and Cosmetology Manager license issued to Cornell Stallworth is reinstated as of October 6, 2003.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent Cornell Stallworth shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400), with credit for a payment of \$172.73 made on October 6, 2003. Subsequent payments shall be in the amount of \$173 and paid on the last day of every month, with the next payment due November 31, 2003. Payments shall be made by certified check or money order payable to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Cornell Stallworth fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the Barbering and Cosmetology Manager license of Cornell Stallworth SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until respondent has complied with the terms of this order.
