The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

- 1. **Superior Barber Shop** is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Establishment license # 80 27577. This license was first granted to it on 06/10/98. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for this establishment is 329 W. North Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53212.
- 2. **Willie C. Corder,** ("Corder") is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Superior Barber Shop. As owner, Corder was at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with Wis. Stats. chapter 454 and Admin. Code chapters BC 2, BC 3 and BC 4.
- 3. Corder is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Manager, license # 81 19923. This license was first granted to him on 08/20/59. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Corder is 3508 N. 16<sup>th</sup> St., Milwaukee, WI 53206.
- 4. On September 11, 2002, an investigator from the Department of Regulation and Licensing performed an inspection at Superior Barber Shop. During the inspection the investigator observed Lynn T. Adams, an employee of Superior Barber Shop, providing services to a client. Adams' apprenticeship permit was cancelled on December 18, 2001. During the inspection on September 11, 2002, the investigator discovered that Ronald Corder had worked in the establishment from January 21, 2000, until September 2002, without an apprentice permit or a license. Department records indicated that Ronald Corder's temporary permit expired December 20, 1998.
- 5. During the inspection on September 11, 2002, the investigator could not locate a supply of bandages and also found the equipment, tools and implements were not being maintained in a clean, sanitary and safe condition

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to sec. 454.15, Wis. Stats.
- 2. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
  - 3. Respondents **Superior Barber Shop & Willie C. Corder** have violated:
    - a. Wisconsin Statutes section 454.04(1)(a), and Wisconsin Administrative Code sections 2.06(4) and BC 2.04(1) by authorizing unlicensed employees to provide services to clients.
    - b. Wisconsin Administrative Code section BC 4.01(1) by failing to maintain the salon in a clean, sanitary and safe condition.
    - c. Wisconsin Administrative Code sections BC 4.04(2) and BC 3.01(8) by failing to supply bandages.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondents **Superior Barber Shop & Willie C. Corder** shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED dollars (\$2,200.00). \$500.00 down payment shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this order and payments of \$154.55 will be due on the first of every consecutive month there after until the full \$2,200.00 is paid. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: **Department Monitor**, **Division of Enforcement**, **Department of Regulation and Licensing**, **PO Box 8935**, **Madison**, **WI 53708-8935**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event **Superior Barber Shop & Willie C. Corder** fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the Barbering and Cosmetology Establishment license of **Superior Barber Shop** and the Barbering and Cosmetology Manager license of **Willie C. Corder** SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file, 02 BAC 031 is hereby closed.
