ORDER GRANTING STAY
On May 9, 2003, the Board of nursing entered its Final decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Thurin's license was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that Ms. Thurin could apply for a three month stay of the suspension, and could apply for consecutive renewals of the stay, conditioned upon compliance with conditions and limitations placed on the license. Among these were that she participate in a drug treatment program acceptable to the board, that she attend therapy a minimum of once per week, that she submit to 52 drug and alcohol screens per year, that she attend AA or NA at least once per week, and that she be responsible for submission to the board of quarterly reports from his therapist and his employer. The Order also provided that Ms. Thurin may not have access to controlled substances in his employment setting.
On August 9, 2003, the board considered Ms. Thurin's request for an initial stay of the suspension. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:
<u>ORDER</u>
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Jessica M. Thurin, RN, is hereby stayed for a period of three months.
