1. Jodi K. Wolfram, V.T. was born June 21, 1972. Ms. Wolfram's latest address on

file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 1111 Grant Street, Fort Atkinson, WI 53538.

2. Ms. Wolfram is licensed to practice in the state of Wisconsin as a veterinarian technician pursuant to license #51-9200696.
3. Ms. Wolfram was employed as an Executive Director for the Humane Society of Jefferson County from January 2000 to April 15, 2001.
4. On exact dates unknown, but beginning in January 2000 and continuing on through April 15, 2001, Ms. Wolfram neutered an unknown number of male cats using Ketamine as an anesthetic.
5. Ketamine is a controlled substance, which the Drug Enforcement Agency only permits the Humane Society of Jefferson County to use for purposes of euthanasia.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to § 453.07, Stats.
2. The Veterinary Examining Board has the authority to resolve this disciplinary proceeding by Stipulation without an evidentiary hearing pursuant to § 227.44 (5), Stats.
3. The conduct described in paragraph 4, above, constitutes a violation of Wis. Admin. Code secs. VE 9.05 (3) and (4).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jodi K. Wolfram, V.T. is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jodi K. Wolfram, V.T. shall pay costs in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY dollars (\$150.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by *certified check or money order*, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:
