The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision in this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and finds it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Kathy Lu Lim (license #85-2636, granted on 09/27/96) is the owner of Chic Nails, a manicuring establishment located at 725 N. High Point Road, Madison, WI 53717, (license #71-1489, granted on 08/05/99).
2. The latest address for Kathy Lu Lim on record with the Department of Regulation and Licensing, (hereafter "Department"), is 725 N. High Point Road, Madison, WI 53717.
3. As the owner of a manicuring establishment, Kathy Lu Lim was at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with Wisconsin Statute, Chapter 454 and the Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology Chapters BC 2, 3 and 4.
4. On July 24, 2002, an announced establishment inspection was performed by the Department. The inspection revealed that facial and waxing services were being provided. A sign advertising waxing services was displayed in the window of the establishment and a treatment room was set up to perform waxing and facials.
5. At the time of the inspection, Chic Nails did not have an aesthetics establishment license. An aesthetics license was subsequently obtained on July 25, 2002.
6. The inspector found dirty disinfectant was located at one of the workstations, clean towels were located on an uncovered shelf, disposable supplies were stored in uncovered containers, a dirty disposable file was left on top of a cabinet in the supply room and metal implements were stored with used disposable files.
7. The inspector also found poisonous substances stored in a public bathroom within the reach of children and not in a locked cabinet.
8. In resolution of this matter, Kathy Lu Lim, D/B/A Chic Nails, consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Kathy Lu Lim, as the owner of a licensed establishment, Chic Nails, has violated the following:

1. Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology BC 2.04(1) by assisting in the unauthorized or unlicensed practice of barbering and cosmetology, aesthetics, electrology or manicuring.
2. Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology BC 3.01(6) by failing to store poisonous substances in a locked cabinet or closet if held in public areas.
3. Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology BC 4.0(1) by failing to maintain equipment, tools and implements used by licensees for services in an establishment in clean, sanitary and safe condition;
4. Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology BC 4.02(3a) by failing to store clean

disinfected contact equipment in a covered container;

5. Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology BC 4.10(1)(b) by failing to change disinfectant on a daily basis.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Kathy Lu Lim, D/B/A Chic Nails, is hereby **RERIMANDED** and shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of one thousand four hundred dollars (\$1,400.00) within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order.

In the event that Kathy Lu Lim, D/B/A Chic Nails, fails to comply with the conditions set forth within the Stipulation and Order, the establishment license of Chic Nails (#71-1489) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
