The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. **Melisa S. Sonnenburg** ("Sonnenburg") date of birth 05/15/81, is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Practitioner license # 82 79960. This license was first granted to her

on 03/28/01. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Sonnenburg is 3170 Center Rd., Cedarburg, WI 53012.

2. At all times relevant to this action, Sonnenburg was working as a Barbering and Cosmetology Practitioner at Absolute Perfection Beauty Cafe.

3. On or about June 13, 2002, an inspection of Absolute Perfection Beauty Cafe was performed by a Department of Regulation and Licensing investigator. During the inspection the investigator established that Sonnenburg was providing hair styling services to clients. The Absolute Perfection Beauty Cafe is licensed as a manicuring establishment not a barbering and cosmetology establishment. On July 1, 2001, the Absolute Perfection Beauty Cafe manicuring establishment license expired and was not renewed until July 11, 2002.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to sec. 454.15, Wis. Stats.

2. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.

3. Respondent **Melisa S. Sonnenburg** has violated Wisconsin Statutes sections 454.08(1)(b) and 454.15(2)(i) and Wisconsin Administrative Code section BC 2.04(1) by providing services to clients in an unlicensed establishment.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent **Melisa S. Sonnenburg** shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of FIVE HUNDRED dollars (\$500.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: **Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing , PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event **Melisa S. Sonnenburg** fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the license of **Melisa S. Sonnenburg** SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file, 01 BAC 105 be, and hereby is, closed as to Melisa S. Sonnenburg.
