The parties having agreed to the attached stipulation, the Veterinary Examining Board makes the following

Findings of Fact

1. Kristen N. Temo, D.V.M., was born on November 7, 1974, and is licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 5051, first granted on May 10, 2000.
2. Dr. Temo was a resident of the state of Maryland at the time she was first licensed in Wisconsin.
3. Dr. Temo relocated to Wisconsin, and has been employed in a veterinary medicine residency program at the Animal Emergency

Center in Milwaukee from and after July 1, 2000.

4. Dr. Temo failed to notify the Department of Regulation and Licensing of her change of address, and therefore the license registration notice sent to her by the Department was mailed to Maryland.

5. Dr. Temo's license registration expired on December 31, 2001.

6. Dr. Temo continued to practice veterinary medicine in Wisconsin without current registration until April 17, 2003, the day she was notified by a telephone call from an investigator for the Division of Enforcement that her license registration had expired. Dr. Temo renewed her registration on April 18, 2003.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to s. 453.07(2), Stats.

2. Dr. Temo's inadvertent conduct of practicing veterinary medicine without current license registration violated s. VE 9.05(11), Wis. Admin. Code.

Order

It is ordered that Kristen Temo, D.V.M., is reprimanded.

It is further ordered that Dr. Temo pay the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$130.00 to the Department of Regulation and Licensing within 60 days of the date of this Order.
