Accordingly, the Board in this matte	er adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Westen H. Anderson (date of birth: August 29, 1936) is licensed by the Funeral Directors Examining Board as a funeral director in the State of Wisconsin (License #3672). The license was first granted on July 23, 1963.

- 2. Respondent's last address reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 3640 23rd Avenue South, Minneapolis, MN 55407.
- 3. Respondent did not complete the requisite 15 hours of continuing education during the January 1, 2000, through December 31, 2001, biennium, prior to renewing his Funeral Director's license for the January 1, 2002, through December 30, 2003 biennium.
- 4. Respondent wishes to surrender his Funeral Director License.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to Sec. 445.13, Stats.
- 2. The Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation, pursuant to Sec. 227.44(5), Stats.
- 3. Respondent failed to obtain the 15 hours of Board approved continuing education during the biennium immediately preceding his application for the renewal of his license for the January 1, 2000, through December 30, 2001, biennium as required by Sec.445.06, Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ FD 4.03, and FD 4.04, and therefore is subject to Sec. 445.13, Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Wisconsin Funeral Directors Board ACCEPTS the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the Funeral Director License of Westen H. Anderson (#3672).
- 2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Respondent reapply for a Wisconsin Funeral Directors License, the Funeral Directors Board may, in its sole discretion, determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, a license may be issued.
- 3. Upon signing of the attached Stipulation, Respondent **shall submit all indicia of licensure.** These documents shall be sent to:
