The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the Final
Decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects,
Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors – Professional Engineer Section ("Board"). The Board has
reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Aliasgher Houshmand ("Respondent") (DOB 4-11-47; 13297 Portofino Dr., Delmar, CA 92014) is duly licensed as a professional engineer in the State of Wisconsin (license #6-33439). This license was granted on April 19, 1999.

2. On or about September 25, 2001, an investigation by the California Board for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors ("Cal. Board") revealed that Respondent violated secs. 6787(f), (h), and (j) and 6732 of the California Business and Professions Code. The records of the Cal. Board showed that Respondent was not licensed by the Cal. Board as a Professional Engineer.

3. That investigation also revealed that Respondent represented that he was licensed as a civil engineer and used the initials "P.E." on his business cards and in signing contracts while working for the Department of the Navy at Camp Pendleton, California.

4. Respondent was ordered to cease and desist violating the law and to pay administrative fines to the Cal. Board. The administrative fines have been paid, and Respondent entered into a Settlement Agreement under which he agreed not to contest the Citation Order. See California Citation Order, Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

5. Through the conduct identified by the State of California, Respondent has failed to comply with all other state regulations, namely California, which relate to the practice of professional engineering and has engaged in conduct which adversely affected his fitness to practice professional engineering.

6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to sec. 443.11, Wis. Stats.
2. The Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
3. Respondent has violated:
 - a. Secs. A-E 8.03(3)(a) and 8.09, Wis. Adm. Code, by failing to comply with all other state regulations which relate to the practice of professional engineering and by engaging in conduct which adversely affected his fitness to practice professional engineering.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **VOLUNTARY SURRENDER** of the Professional Engineer license of Respondent **ALIASGHER HOUSHMAND**, license #6-33439, is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all rights and privileges hereto granted to Respondent **Aliasgher**

Houshmand pursuant to professional engineer license #6-33439 are forever terminated effective at 11:59 p.m. on the date of this Order as set forth below.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Aliasgher Houshmand, and any entity owned or controlled in whole or in part by him, shall not be granted a credential under Chapter 443 of the Wisconsin Statutes at any time in the future. The denial, in whole or in part, of any petition or license application by **Aliasgher Houshmand**, and any entity owned or controlled in whole or in part by him, for a credential authorized under Chapter 443 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall not constitute a denial of a license and shall not give rise to a contested case within the meaning of secs. 227.01(3) and 227.42 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that file 99 ENG 009 be, and hereby is, closed.
