The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lisa M. Marge("Marg"), date of birth 07/19/69, was at all times relevant to the facts employed at the barbering and cosmetology establishment Grace’s Salon De Beaute` Inc., license # 80-29995, located at

2. From October 2001 until October 2002, Marg was providing services for clients without a valid barbering or cosmetology practitioner's license.

3. On December 11, 2002, Marg received a temporary barbering and cosmetology permit from the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

4. On February 19, 2003, Marg received a State of Wisconsin Barbering or Cosmetology Practitioner license, # 82-81734.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to sec. 454.15, Wis. Stats.

2. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.

3. Respondent **Lisa M. Marg** has violated Wisconsin Statutes sections 454.04(1)(a) and 454.15(2)(i) and Wisconsin Administrative Code section BC 2.04(1) by providing services to clients without a current Wisconsin Barbering or Cosmetology Practitioner license.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent **Lisa M. Marg** shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of **ONE THOUSAND** Dollars (\$1000.00). Payment shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: **Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event **Lisa M. Marg** fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the Barbering or Cosmetology Practitioner's license of **Lisa M. Marg** SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file 03 BAC 032 be, and hereby is closed.
