The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Land Surveyor Section, Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors ("Section"). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent Douglas P. Martin (date of birth: April 7, 1947) is duly licensed to practice as a land surveyor in the state of Wisconsin (license #8-2004). This license was first granted on November 29, 1989.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 3410 East Lincolnshire Boulevard, Toledo, OH 43606.
3. On March 8, 2001, the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors imposed discipline against Respondent's license to practice as a professional surveyor in Ohio. A true and correct copy of the Ohio Board's Settlement Agreement is attached to this document as **Exhibit A** and is incorporated herein by

reference.

4. On August 12, 2003, the Department of Regulation and Licensing received confirmation that Respondent completed the terms of the Ohio Board's Settlement Agreement and his registration there was reinstated on September 10, 2001. A copy of the Ohio Board's letter confirming this information is attached as **Exhibit B** and is incorporated herein by reference.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The State of Wisconsin Land Surveyors Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors has jurisdiction to act in this matter and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §443.12, Wis. Stats..

2. Respondent has violated state laws, local ordinances or administrative rules relating to the practice of land surveying by his misconduct described in paragraph 3 above, and thereby has violated §A-E 8.09(1), Wis. Adm. Code.

3. In light of the foregoing, Respondent has misconducted himself in the practice of land surveying, as provided in §A-E 8.03(3)(a), Wis. Adm. Code.

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent **Douglas P. Martin**, license #8-2004, is hereby **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file 01 LRS 009 be, and hereby is, closed.
