On February 8, 1994, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order accepting the voluntary surrender of the license of Edward D. Carr to practice as a pharmacist. At its meeting on May 14, 1996, the board considered respondent's request for reinstatement of his license, as well as various documentation submitted in support thereof. On May 23, 1996, the board ordered that a limited license to practice pharmacy be issued to Edward D. Carr. At its February 12, 2003, meeting, the board considered the petition by Edward D. Carr to be restored to an unlimited license to practice pharmacy. Mr. Carr appeared before the board. The board considered Mr. Carr's past history of discipline before the board and the nature of violations leading to the board's interest in issuing a limited license. Mr. Carr represented that his word could be trusted as evidence to support the current removal of all limitations from his license. Mr. Carr presented no other evidence in support of his petition.

Based upon the board's review;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of, Edward D. Carr, for the reinstatement of an unlimited license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin is granted in part, and that paragraphs (4) four, and (5) five, are removed from the order of May 23, 1996. In all other and further respects the remaining limitations contained in the May 23, 1996 order remain in full force and effect.
