On December 10, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Charlene Willis, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of her license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order"*) dated October 10, 1995. Also requested by Willis was a reduction in individual/group therapy. Also requested was an increase in the number of pharmacist in charge hours allowed and a reduction in drug urine screens. Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Charlene Willis, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #11555 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request that the board modify the individual/group therapy counseling sessions from the current frequency of two times (2x) per month, is granted to be reduced to a frequency of one (1x) time per month.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for an increase in the number of hours practicing as a pharmacist in charge is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to reduce the drug urine screens is granted, to a frequency of six (6) times per month.
