On January 14, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for an unlimited license as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated August 12, 1998. The *Order* required five years of the practice of pharmacy in compliance with the terms of the *Order*. Moon had previously been granted credit by the board against the five year practice period required by the *Order*, for the time period from December 1, 1997 to August 12, 1998. Mr. Moon was notified to appear personally before the board but failed to appear.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., license #10536, for restoration to full licensure, is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of suspension of license #10536, to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin.
