On August 13, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the petition by Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated December 8, 1998, LS 9812084 PHM, and a petition for unobserved urine collections, and that Iverson be able to work four to six hours per week as a pharmacist in charge and close the pharmacy one or two days per week.

Based upon the board's review and consideration of the current petitions and supporting documentation:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8239 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request for unobserved urine collections is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request to work as a pharmacist in charge is GRANTED for a total of (2) two hours per week. Iverson MAY NOT open or close the pharmacy.
