On March 26, 2002, the Chiropractic Examining Board (Board) issued its Second Final Decision and Order Following Remand in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Board’s Order, the Respondent’s license to practice chiropractic was revoked. On October 16, 2003, Dr. Golde and his attorney, John B. Wolfe, appeared before the Board and requested that Dr. Golde’s license to practice chiropractic be reinstated.

The Board reviewed Dr. Golde’s request and supporting documentation. Based upon the seriousness of Dr. Golde’s conduct for which he was disciplined and his underlying conviction, the Board does not believe that he has demonstrated sufficient rehabilitation such that his license to practice as a chiropractor should be reinstated.
