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ORDER RESTORING FULL LICENSURE

On November 4, 1998, the Dentistry Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Board’s Order, the Respondent was reprimanded and his license was suspended for a period of not less than five years, with the possibility that the suspension be stayed at four-month intervals. The Order further provided that, *inter alia*, Dr. Moon participate in a rehabilitation, monitoring, and treatment program. It also provided that upon a showing by Dr. Moon of his compliance with the conditions of the Order that he would be eligible for the return of his full license.

On March 5, 2003, the Board reviewed the request of Craig W. Moon, D.D.S., for the return of his dental license without restrictions pursuant to the Board’s *Final Decision and Order* dated November 4, 1998, and as subsequently amended by the Order dated July 10, 2002. Therefore, based upon that request and upon evidence of Dr. Moon’s compliance with the terms and conditions on his license,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all the limitations on the license of Craig W. Moon to practice as a dentist in Wisconsin are lifted and he is restored to full licensure.
