On December 10, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated March 10, 1999, and that the board "greatly reduce" urine screens required by the *Order*. In its September 9, 2003, order the board reduced urine screens to six times per month.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Karwoski, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9334 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to reduce the monthly required urine screens is granted to four (4) times per month.
