IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to modify the *Order* to reduce the frequency of required drug urine screens is granted, to a total of (6) six times per month.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to modify the *Order* to reduce the frequency of required individual/group therapy, is denied.
