On April 9, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for modification of the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated March 10, 1999, to reduce the frequency of required urine screens under the *Order*, and allowing that he be allowed to work as a pharmacist in charge.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request to modify the *Order* to reduce the frequency of required urine screens, is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDER that the request to work as a pharmacist in charge, is GRANTED, for a total of four (4) hours per week, but Karwoski may not open or close the pharmacy.
