ORDER REINSTATING FULL LICENSURE

On November 7, 1999, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require, among other conditions, that Dr. Kruse complete within one year from the date of the Order a 40 hour course in prescribing controlled substances, and an educational program established through the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine on medical recordkeeping.

On December 20, 2000, the board considered evidence that Dr. Kruse had satisfactorily completed the controlled substance prescribing course. The board also considered a letter from Thomas C. Meyer, M.D., of the medical school, indicating that Dr. Kruse had made satisfactory progress in her educational program, had completed approximately one-half of the educational program, and was scheduled to complete it in April or May, 2001. Based upon this information, the board extended the deadline to July 1, 2001.

On March 19, 2003, the board considered Dr. Kruse's request for termination of all limitations in her license. The board also considered information indicating that Dr. Kruse has satisfactorily completed all requirements of the board's November 17, 1999 Order. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license Diana L. Kruse, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin are terminated, and Dr. Kruse is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
