On March 4, 2004, pursuant to the Order currently in effect against the applicant for licensure, KIMBERLY M. NICKLIN, appeared personally before the Board of Nursing seeking removal of the limitations upon her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the limitations upon the license of KIMBERLY M. NICKLIN, to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin shall remain in effect without modification.

1. The applicant did not appear to take responsibility for actions. The restrictions upon her license set forth in the decision of the Colorado Board of Nursing, dated June 6, 2001, which prohibit her from employment as a nurse, caregiver or volunteer in a home health care, long term care, or hospice facility for a period of five years, shall remain in effect.
2. Furthermore, the applicant may only petition the Wisconsin Board of Nursing for termination of the limitations on her Wisconsin license only upon a showing that the Respondent is restored to full licensure in Colorado.
