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REVOCATION OF LIMITED LICENSE

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On May 23, 2002, the Department of Regulation and Licensing issued its Order Adopting the Stipulation in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Department's order, applicant's license to practice as a real estate salesperson in Wisconsin was granted under certain limiting conditions. The Order provided that failure by applicant Harris to timely comply with the terms of this limitation and/or any further criminal conviction or violation of any probation term shall result in the revocation of applicant Harris's limited real estate salesperson's license without further notice or hearing or other proceeding.

On December 19, 2003, the Department found that Mr. Harris had failed to file the necessary quarterly reports with the Department. The Department also found that according Mr. Harris's probation agent he violated his probation and was in prison.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the limited real estate salesperson license of Robert L. Harris is revoked.
