### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On November 11, 2000, the Professional Engineers Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors imposed disciplinary action against the Respondent in this matter. The November Order required Respondent on a quarterly basis to submit a complete and detailed description of all engineering work that Respondent had performed in the state of Wisconsin during the preceding three-month reporting period. On February 3, 2004, Respondent notified the Department Monitor of his intent to surrender his Wisconsin license to practice as a professional engineer.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Sandip K. Guha (D.O.B. 01/01/45) is duly licensed to practice as a Professional Engineer in the state of Wisconsin (license #34041). This license was first granted on March 28, 2000.
- Mr. Guha's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Professional Engineer Section is 250 South 6th Street, Boise, ID 83702.
- 3. On November 11, 2000, the Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors imposed disciplinary action against Mr. Guha.
- 4. The November Order of the Section required Respondent on a quarterly basis to submit a complete and detailed description of all engineering work that Respondent had performed in the state of Wisconsin during the preceding three-month reporting period.
- 5. On February 3, 2004, Mr. Guha notified the Department Monitor of his intent to surrender his Wisconsin license to practice as a professional engineer.

# CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Professional Engineer Section has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to sec. 443.11, Stats.
- The Wisconsin Professional Engineer Section is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Stats.

# **ORDER**

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors ACCEPTS the surrender of the license of Sandip K. Guha to practice as a professional engineer in the state of Wisconsin (license #34041).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Mr. Guha reapply for Wisconsin licensure, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, a license may be reissued.

This Order became effective on February 26, 2004.
