On December 9, 2004, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of his limited license to practice as registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to the Order dated January 4, 2001, currently in effect. The information presented indicated that the petitioner has been non-compliant with the terms and conditions of the Board's original order, and the subsequent order dated September 21 2004, which required that the petitioner enroll with a Board approved provider of drug screens prior to the obtaining a stay of the suspension. The information presented to the Board showed that the petitioner has been working as a RN since September 30, 2004, without meeting the requirements for a stay. Based upon all information of record herein, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a further three-month stay of the suspension of the limited license of LEE ALLEN DZIATKIEWICZ, #130108, to practice as a RN in Wisconsin is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner shall not be allowed to submit a petition for a further stay of the suspension of license for **six (6) months** from the date of this order. The petitioner shall submit satisfactory evidence of enrollment with the Board-approved First Lab Program and proof of his compliance with the drug screening requirements at the time that he submits another petition for a stay of the suspension.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date signed below.
