On June 10, 2004, pursuant to the Order currently in effect against Paul Lauer, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a further three month stay of the suspension. The Department Monitor presented evidence of Mr. Lauer's admission of recent diversion and dilution of urine samples. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that

1. The request for extension of the limited license of Paul Lauer, #106610, to practice RN in Wisconsin is hereby denied.
2. The limited license of Paul V. Lauer, #106610, to practice RN in Wisconsin is suspended for a minimum of six months.
3. Mr. Lauer must show full compliance with the original Board order and submit a letter from his therapist before petitioning the Board.
