On April 22, 2004, the Board of Nursing considered the Petitioner's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of his license practical nurse license. Also, the Petitioner requested a reduction in the number of his required drug and alcohol urine screens. Based upon all information of record herein, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license (#27768) of Lynn R. Schober to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin is hereby stayed for a further period of three months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner's request for a decrease in the drug and alcohol urine screens is DENIED on the basis that the Petitioner was previously granted a reduction in October 2003 and his current level of testing is deemed necessary and appropriate. Petitioner will not eligible for an additional decrease in his urine screens until he has returned to work as a nurse.
