On February 11, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Janet M. Krueger, for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated December 11, 2001. The department monitor also provided evidence that the collection site for the collection of Ms. Krueger's urine samples as required by the *Order*, reported on January 28, 2004, that Ms. Krueger's urine sample collected that date contained powder on the top of the sample, that Ms. Krueger had been spending what was considered a longer time in the bathroom, and that her urine has been different colors over the past few collections.

Based upon the board's review of the documentation submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Janet M. Krueger, R.Ph., is GRANTED a three month stay of the suspension of license #11073 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that all urine speciemens collected for the time period of three months from the date of the signing of this order furnished in a directly witnessed manner pursuant to paragraph 2.b.(4)e., of the *Order*.
