On June 24, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Janet M. Krueger, for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* (“*Order*”) dated December 11, 2001. Ms. Krueger also submitted a request for a reduction in urine screens under paragraph 2b.(4)b.(2) of the Order, to a minimum of 72 per year for the second year of the practice of pharmacy under the *Order*.

Based upon the board’s review of the documentation submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Janet M. Krueger, R.Ph., is GRANTED a three month stay of the suspension of license #11073 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that under paragraph 2b.(4)b.(2) of the Order, Krueger is reduced to a minimum of 72 drug urine screens per year for the second year of the practice of pharmacy under *Order*.
