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ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On July 7, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Dr. Moldenhauer for all of the following:

- (1) A three-month extension of the stay of suspension;
- (2) A reduction in the number of urine screens to forty (40) per year; and
- (3) A reduction in the number of monthly group therapy sessions.

Based upon the Board's review,

IT IS ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer be granted a three-month stay of the suspension of License #015-3331 to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the requests of Blair D. Moldenhauer, D.D.S., for a reduction in the number of urine screens and a reduction in the number of monthly group therapy sessions are DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer's license to practice dentistry remains subject to the terms and conditions as set forth in the Board's *Final Decision and Order* dated January 9, 2002, and any subsequent Board Orders.

Please be advised that the next submission of reports and the petition for an extension of a stay of suspension are due on September 15, 2004.
