ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On May 5, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by John F. Reed, D.D.S., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided in the Board’s *Final Decision and Order* dated March 6, 2002. The Board also considered Dr. Reed’s request for a reduction in the required number of urine screens and whether he should be permitted to reapply for his DEA number.

Based upon the Board’s review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that John F. Reed, D.D.S., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of License #015-3877 to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Reed’s request to reduce the number of monthly urine screens is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Reed’s request to reapply for his DEA number is DENIED.

Please be advised that the next submission of reports and the petition for an extension of a stay of suspension are due on June 15, 2004.
