On March 21, 2002, the Chiropractic Examining Board (Board) issued a stipulated Order in the above-captioned matter. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all the limitations on the license of Troy E. Bruesewitz, D.C., to practice as a chiropractor in Wisconsin are lifted and he is restored to full licensure.
