On August 11, 2004, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Lance J. Lundstad, for a three month stay of suspension as provided in the board’s *Final Decision and Order* dated June 12, 2002. (“*Order*”) Also requested by Lundstad was a reduction in the frequency of required individual/group therapy sessions under paragraph 2b.(2) of the *Order* from the current frequency of once every week to once every three or four weeks. The therapy reduction request was supported by his therapist. The department monitor informed the board that on August 11, 2004, she spoke with Lundstad, who informed her that within the last two weeks he had consumed alcohol, driven and been arrested.

Based upon the board’s review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Lance J. Lundstad, R.Ph., is denied a three month stay of the suspension of license #12304 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Lundstad’s request to decrease the frequency of required individual/group therapy sessions under paragraph 2b.(2) of the *Order* from the current frequency of once every week, denied.
