On November 4, 2004, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for a three month stay of the suspension of her limited license; request for approval of a new worksite and approval for reduction in her urine screens, pursuant to the Order dated July 11, 2002, currently in effect against petitioner. Based upon all information of record herein, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that

1. Mary B. Kramer is hereby GRANTED a further three month stay of suspension of her licensed practical nurse license (#21417) in Wisconsin.
2. The petitioner's request for approval of her new worksite is hereby APPROVED.
3. The petitioner's request for a reduction in her urine screens is hereby DENIED and the petitioner is required to immediately enroll with the First Lab program to administer her urine screens. Petitioner shall be permitted to continue with her current provider for screening only until the transition to First Labs is completed.
4. This Order is effective upon the date of signing below and is continuous from the time of the expiration of the previous stay.
