On April 7, 2003, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order adopting a stipulation in this case. The order required respondents Absolute Perfection Beauty Café and Lorraine K. Pellien to pay a forfeiture of \$3,000 within 60 days of the order, and that “in the event Absolute Perfection Beauty Café and Lorraine K. Pellien fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the licenses of Absolute Perfection Beauty Café and Lorraine K. Pellien SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until respondents have complied with the terms of this order”. On October 6, 2003, the Department Monitor reported to the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board that as of that date no payment had been made, and on October 13, 2003, an Order was issued suspending the licenses of Lorraine K. Pellien and Absolute Perfection Beauty Café.

On August 9, 2004, the Department Monitor reported that the payment had been made, and the Board agreed to terminate the license suspension and to reinstate the manicurist license held by Lorraine K. Pellien. Ms. Pellien has indicated that she will be applying for a new establishment license, and although the suspension is lifted from the establishment license issued to Absolute Perfection Beauty Café, the license is not reinstated at this time.

IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the Manicurist license issued to Lorraine K. Pellien and the Manicurist Establishment license issued for Absolute Perfection Beauty Café are hereby terminated, and that the Manicurist license issued to Lorraine K. Pellien is reinstated as of August 9, 2004.
