ORDER FIXING COSTS LS0309241MED

On April 18, 2004, the Medical Examining Board filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the board ordered that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent. Pursuant to sec. RL 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about May 3, 2004, the Medical Examining Board received the Affidavit of Costs in the amount of \$1,167.49, filed by Attorney Steven M. Gloe. On or about May 3, 2004, the Medical Examining Board received the Affidavit of Costs of the Office of Legal Counsel in the amount of \$160.48, filed by Administrative Law Judge William A. Black. The Medical Examining Board considered the affidavits of costs on June 16, 2004, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,327.97, set forth in the affidavits of costs of Attorney Steven M. Gloe and Administrative Law Judge William A. Black, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by him to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. Failure of respondent to make payment on or before July 16, 2004 shall constitute a violation of the Order unless respondent petitions for and the board grants a different deadline. Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the department in the full amount assessed.

To ensure that payments for assessed costs are correctly receipted, the attached "Guidelines for Payment of Costs and/or Forfeitures" should be enclosed with the payment.
