This matter was considered by the Auctioneer Board at its regular meeting on April 27, 2004.

BACKGROUND

- 1. Myron C. Bowling, (DOB 4/3/52; 2082 Timberman Rd., Hamilton, OH 45013) is licensed as an auctioneer in the State of Wisconsin (license #52-1117). This license was first granted on March 18, 1997.
- 2. Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. (3901 Kraus Ln., PO Box 369, Ross, OH 45061) is licensed as an auction company in the State of Wisconsin (license #53-278). This license was first granted on February 18, 2003.
- 3. On December 8, 2003, the Auctioneer Board adopted a Final Decision and Order pursuant to a Stipulation signed by the respondents and the Division of Enforcement. A copy of the Final Decision and Order was served on the respondents by certified mail on December 11, 2003.

In its Final Decision and Order, the Board ordered that the respondents' licenses be suspended until the following requirements and conditions are satisfied:

As to Respondent Myron C. Bowling:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the auctioneer's license (#52-1117) of Respondent, Myron C. Bowling, be and hereby is, SUSPENDED until such time that Respondent Myron C. Bowling takes and passes the Continuing Education Test-Out Exam administered by the Department of Regulation and Licensing pursuant to Chapter RL 128 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code. Upon successful completion, Respondent Myron C. Bowling shall submit proof of the same to the

Division of Enforcement Department of Regulation and Licensing PO Box 8935 Madison, WI 53708-8935

in the form of verification from the Department. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any continuing education requirements that are or may be instituted by the Board or the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event Respondent Myron C. Bowling fails to successfully complete the educational requirements in the manner as set forth above, then and in that event, and without further notice to the Respondent Myron C. Bowling, his auctioneer license shall continue to be suspended without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until further Order of the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Myron C. Bowling pay FULL COSTS in this matter in the amount of \$350 within 30 days of the date of this Order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that Respondent Myron C. Bowling fails to pay the \$350 in full costs within the time and in the manner as set forth above, then and in that event, and without further notice to the Respondent, his auctioneer's license shall be suspended without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said full costs have been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and his failure to pay the full costs shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent Myron C. Bowling pay a FORFEITURE of \$1000.00, within 30 days of the date of this Order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event Respondent Myron C. Bowling fails to pay the \$1000.00 forfeiture within the time and in the manner as set forth above, then and in that event, and without further notice to the Respondent Myron C. Bowling his auctioneer license shall be suspended without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said forfeiture have been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and his failure to pay the forfeiture shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Board.

As to Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc.:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the auction company license (#53-278) of Respondent, Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. be and hereby is, SUSPENDED until such time that the following prerequisites are met:

(1) Respondent Myron C. Bowling takes and passes the CONTINUING

- (2) Respondent Myron Bowling Inc. establishes a trust account that conforms with the requirements of Wis. Stats. §480.16, including registering the name with the Department of Regulation and Licensing and providing a consent to audit letter to the Department; AND
- (3) Respondents use a contract form that complies with Chapter 124 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. fails to meet the prerequisites to the lifting of the suspension on its auction company license in the manner set forth above, then and in that event, and without further notice to the Respondent, Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc., its auction company's license shall continue to be suspended without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until further Order of the Board. Upon successful completion of these prerequisites, Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. shall submit proof of the same to the Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. pay FULL COSTS in this matter in the amount of \$350 within 30 days of the date of this Order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. fails to pay the \$350 in full costs within the time and in the manner as set forth above, then and in that event, and without further notice to the Respondent, its auction company's license shall be suspended without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said full costs have been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and its failure to pay the full costs shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. pay a FORFEITURE of \$1000.00, within 30 days of the date of this Order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. fails to pay the \$1000.00 forfeiture within the time and in the manner as set forth above, then and in that event, and without further notice to the Respondent Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc. its auction company's license shall be suspended without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said forfeiture have been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and its failure to pay the forfeiture shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Board

4. On April 27, 2004, the Board received written confirmation that the respondents have complied with all of the

requirements and conditions, as set forth above and as ordered in its Final Decision and Order, dated December 8, 2003.

Based upon the record in this matter, the Board makes the following Order:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, based upon full compliance with the Board's Final Decision and Order dated December 8, 2003, the suspension of Myron Bowling's license to practice as an auctioneer be, and hereby is, removed. Respondent's license is restored to full licensure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, based upon full compliance with the Board's Final Decision and Order dated December 8, 2003, the suspension of the license of Myron Bowling Auctioneers, Inc., to operate as an auction company be, and hereby is, removed. Respondent's license is restored to full licensure.

This order is effective on the date it is signed by a designee of the Auctioneer Board.
